Data of state and UT-wise forest cover (FC) has been obtained from Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India. States and UTs with less than 10% FC are rated as Health Hazard; with 10-19.99% FC as Very Poor; with 20-32.99% as Poor, and those with FC above 33% as Good and Very Good (those with FC above 66%, more than double of one-third geographical area).
